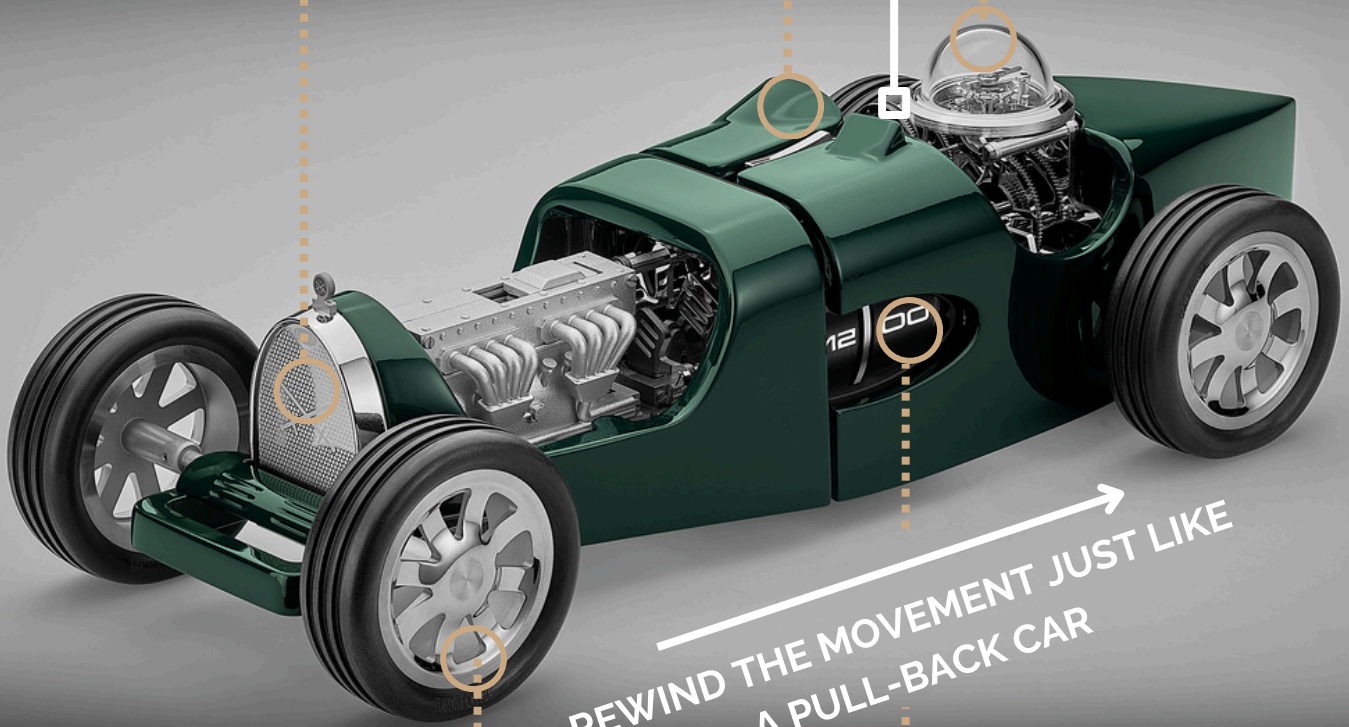


The three spoke steering wheel works as the time setting key

1930's-inspired race car radiator grill

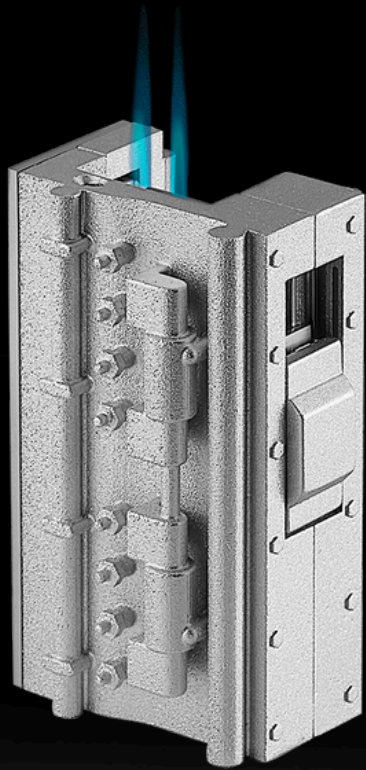
Alluminum bodywork with automotive lacquer - each color recalls a specific race team/country



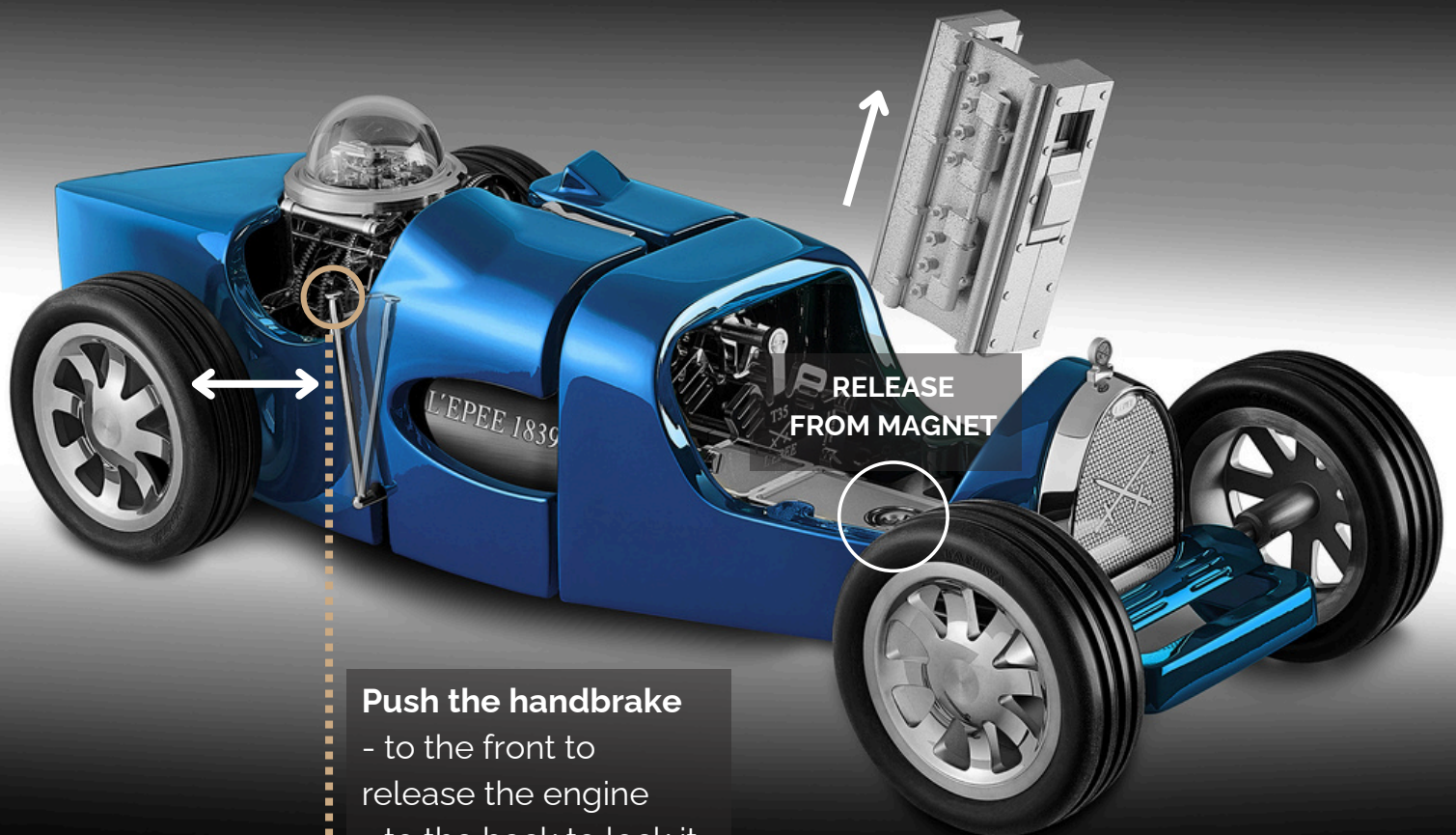
REWIND THE MOVEMENT JUST LIKE A PULL-BACK CAR

Hours and minutes displayed on the side resembling a typical competition number

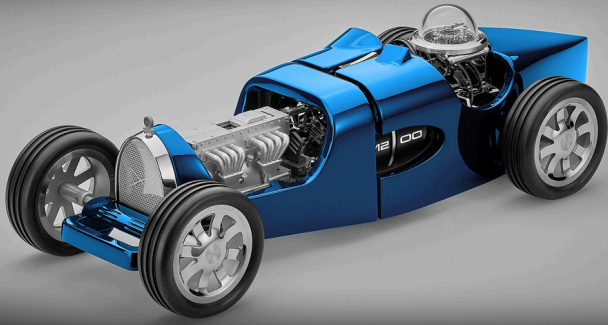

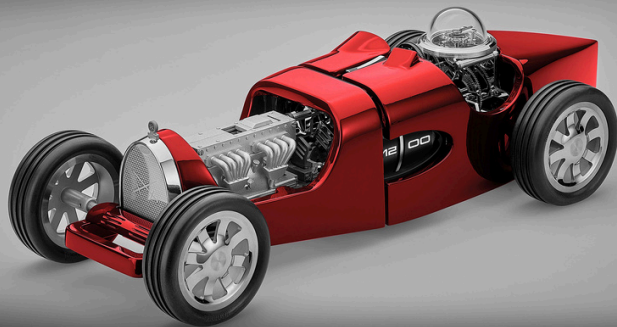

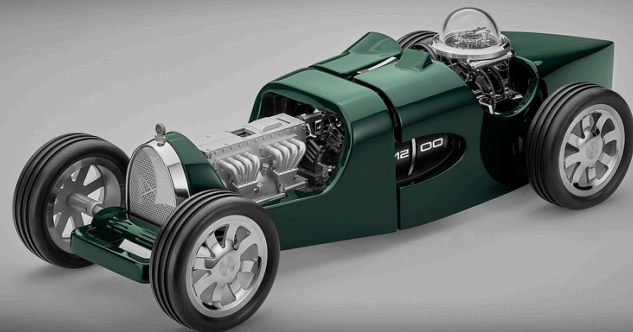

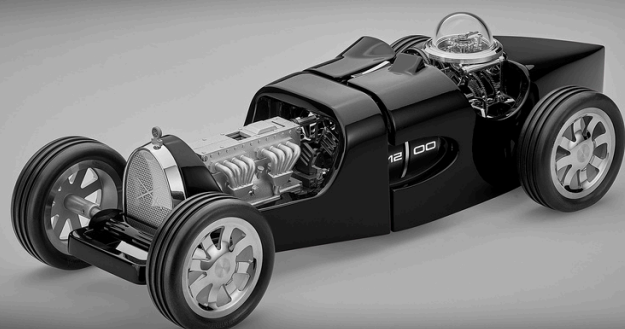
